






FINDING THE RIGHT TERM TO REFER TO THESE PEOPLE IS NOT EASY. MANY TEENAGERS WONDER WHAT WORD TO USE.







IN SHORT, TEENAGERS MAKE A DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE DONOR'S CHILDREN AND THE DONOR-CONCEIVED CHILDREN, EVEN IF IN BOTH CASES, THEY SHARE HALF OF THEIR GENETIC MAKE-UP. THESE TEENAGERS FEEL CLOSER TO THE DONOR-CONCEIVED CHILDREN THAN TO HIS CHILDREN. LIKE THEM, THEY ARE DONOR CONCEIVED AND DO NOT LIVE WITH THE DONOR. IN GENERAL, THE TEENAGERS WE MET WANT TO MEET THEIR DONOR SIBLINGS OR AT LEAST KNOW MORE ABOUT THEM.
